Dear Y11 Students, Parents and Carers

Re: GCSE Results Day and Post Results Services Information

On Thursday 24 August 2023 we would like to invite all Y11 Students to come in to the Upper School Hall at 09:00 – 10:00 to sign for and collect their June 2023 exam results. Results are for the students only, so any uncollected results will be emailed to students' school email addresses as soon as we can between 10:00 – 13:00. These are the only two options available. Thank you to those students who have already advised they will not be attending, your results will be emailed to you between 10:00 – 11:00.

You will receive a results envelope with your results slip advising your overall grade for each subject qualification. GCSE grades range from 9 – 1 where a grade 4 or above is a solid Level 2 pass, and grades 3 or below are a Level 1 pass. BTEC and CNAT grades range from Level 2 Distinction* to Level 1 Pass. (Please note for those students who were entered for GCSE Combined Science you will receive a double award which counts as two GCSE passes.) If you have any queries with your results please liaise with your Subject Teacher and/or Head of Department, many of whom will be available on Results Day.

Please find attached a copy of the Myton School Exams “Post Results Services” information for your reference. If you require any of these services on or after Results Day, please contact the Exams Team via email: exams@myton.co.uk ParentPay options have already been set up should you need to make a payment for any of these requests. Please note all post results services require the written consent of the candidate (not the parent/carer) and payment in full before any requests can be processed. The deadline for all post results services requests is midday on Thursday 28 September 2023.

On Results Day students will also be requested to advise us of their next destination – i.e. work, apprenticeship, college, etc. Please complete the “next destination” column on the “signed for” results sheet when you collect your results envelope. (For those students who are unable to come in to collect their results in person, please email the Exams Team with your next destination information.) We are required to collect this information, so if your destination changes after Results Day, please do let us know.

We look forward to seeing the Y11 students on Results Day and celebrating their achievements. For those planning to return to Myton Sixth Form, the Sixth Form Team will be available to complete the enrolment process straight after you have collected your results.
