Dear Year 11 Students, Parents and Carers

GCSE Results Day, Post Results Services and Certificate Collection Information

On Thursday 22 August 2024 we would like to invite all Year 11 students to come into the Upper School Hall from 09:00 – 10:00 to sign for and collect their June 2024 exam results. Results will be given to the students only, and any uncollected results will be emailed to the student's school email address as soon as possible between 10:00 – 12:00. These are the only two options available. If a student is away on holiday their results will be emailed to their school email address between 10:00 – 12:00.

On GCSE Results Day Year 11 students will receive a results envelope containing their results slip advising their overall grade for each subject qualification. GCSE grades range from 9 – 1 where a grade 4 or above is a Level 2 pass, and grades 3 or below are a Level 1 pass. BTEC and CNAT grades range from Level 2 Distinction*, Distinction, Merit, Pass to Level 1 Distinction, Merit, Pass. Please note for those students who were entered for GCSE Combined Science they will receive a double award which counts as two GCSE passes and GCSE English Language has a spoken language endorsement grade of either Distinction (D), Merit (M), Pass (P) or NC. If a student has any queries with their results they should speak to the Exams Team or liaise directly with their Subject Teacher and/or Head of Department, many of whom will be available on GCSE Results Day. If specific teachers are not available please email them directly and they will respond to you when the school re-opens in September.

Please find attached a copy of the Myton School Exams Post Results Services information for your reference. If a student requires any of these services on or after GCSE Results Day, they should contact the Exams Team via their school email address to exams@myton.co.uk. ParentPay options will be set up should you need to make a payment for any of these requests. Please note all post results services require the written consent of the candidate (not the parent/carer) and payment in full (if applicable) before any requests can be processed. The deadline for all post results service requests is midday on Thursday 26 September 2024.

On GCSE Results Day students will also be requested to advise us of their next destination – i.e., work, apprenticeship, college, sixth form, etc. Students will be asked to complete the 'next destination' column on the 'signed for' results sheet when they collect their results envelope. For those students who are unable to come in to collect their results in person they will need to email the Careers Department directly with their next destination information to careers@myton.co.uk. We are required to collect this information so if a student's destination changes after GCSE Results Day, they must email the Careers Department directly to let them know.

We look forward to seeing the Year 11 students on GCSE Results Day and celebrating their achievements. For those planning to return to Myton Sixth Form, the Sixth Form Team will be available to complete the enrolment process straight after the students have collected their results. Please email sixthform@myton.co.uk if you have any Myton Sixth Form queries either prior to, on, or after GCSE Results Day. Certificates will be available for students to sign for and collect on Monday 16 December 2024 from the reception area in the new Sixth Form building from 13:00 – 15:30. Alternatively, certificates can be posted out via the RM signed for service upon receipt of the ParentPay payment in full for the 'Exam certificate postal option' (which can accept payments until 31 August 2024 only).
