

## **Myton School**

### **Statement on the Financial Support Policy**

Myton School recognises that in addition to students eligible for free school meals there are other families that might need assistance during their child's education at Myton School to participate in trips.

A financial support fund has been established to try and support these

families. The basic principles of the policy are as follows:

#### **Trips:**

- Applications need to be made at the start of the trip before committing to the trip and paying the deposit.
- For changes in financial circumstances once a place has been reserved on the trip and the deposit paid – applications will be considered provided a change in circumstance can be proven and the applicant has been making regular payments towards the trip.
- For trips over £40 the maximum funding towards the trip will not normally exceed £150 or more than 25% of the trip cost. Only one such award per child per year will normally be considered.
- For core curriculum trips under £40 – funding will be 75%

#### **Other Requests:**

- Uniform Assistance – up to a maximum of £75.00 per child per academic year
- Curriculum Materials – available from the school finance office up to a maximum of £20.00 per child per academic year
- Music Lessons – up to 50% discount per term for one instrument

#### **General**

- A template form for applicants to complete along with supporting evidence/documentation to validate their claim.
- All requests will be considered on a case by case basis.

The school will manage the number and size of funding given in order to keep within the budget of the funds available.

The school has based its assessment criteria for eligibility for funding on the needs and circumstances of our young people and subject to equalities legislation, as follows:

Students previously eligible for free school meals and whose family income is below £16,190 per year  
Students from households on incomes less than £22,000 per year  
Students from households on incomes less than £27,500 per year  
Any other circumstances which may lead to barriers to participation e.g. young carers, sudden financial hardship, number of siblings etc

**If you think you may be entitled to assistance with funding towards a school trip please complete the attached application form and return with accompanying documentation to our Finance Office. If you need support with the completion of the form please contact our Finance Office to arrange a meeting.**

All information received will be treated in strictest confidence and copies of evidence of eligibility will be retained and stored securely for audit purposes.

**If your circumstances change during the year and you suddenly fall into the criteria above, you may apply for assistance at any time.**

If you wish to appeal against a decision please follow the school's complaints procedure available on request from the Head Teacher's PA.
