



WHAT ARE YOUR OPTIONS?



Young people have a **choice** about how they continue in education or training post-16, which could be:



Full-time study

in a school, college or with a training provider



Full-time work

full-time work or volunteering (20 hours or more) combined with regulated part-time education or training (about one day per week)



Apprenticeship

An apprenticeship (www.apprenticeships.org.uk) or traineeship

Department for Education

Participation of young people in education, employment or training

Local Authorities have a duty to ensure that all young people who reach the age of 16 or 17 in any given academic year are entitled to an offer of a viable place at a suitable provider to continue in education or training in the following year



WHAT ARE YOUR OPTIONS?



Your responsibility is to research all of the options available to you; it is ultimately your choice - it is best you make an **informed choice**



Attend open events at potential Sixth Forms/Colleges e.g., Myton, Warwickshire College etc.





Register for apprenticeship alerts via the National Apprenticeship Service



Contact training providers/prospective employers about what they have available **Send in a CV** with an outline of what you are hoping to do


