Further detail: Uniform Expectations

Shoes: must be black, leather style with no sports logos. This means no Air Force Ones or trainers with bubbles in the sole.

Blazer: must be the school black blazer. A blazer is to be worn at all times around the school site. It can be removed when in lessons.

Skirts: black pleated skirt will be compulsory for all students from September 2023. These must not be rolled at the waistband. Please note students who are currently in the old style skirt must have these replaced by the new term.

Trousers: Plain black school trousers. No leggings or jean style trousers.

Shirts: White school shirt. Top button done up and shirts tucked in. Please note that ties must be worn with shirts for all students.

Ties: Tie compulsory for all students from September 2023.

Socks: Plain black, grey or white. No fluffy socks or sports logos.

Jumpers: Black v-neck only. These are an optional item of uniform. The blazer must always be worn, but if a jumper is worn in addition, it must be plain black, v-neck and with no logos.

Jewellery: A single stud earring in each ear; no facial piercings including nose studs; no other jewellery permitted. Piercings other than a single stud in each ear will need to be removed.

Nails: No coloured nail varnish or acrylic nails allowed. Nails should be kept to a sensible length that will not affect safety and participation in PE, other practical subjects, or a student's ability to write.

Make up: must be light and insignificant.

Hair: no extreme hairstyles, including colours/cuts.

PE uniform: there are some elements required for health and safety purposes. The following sport-specific safety items will be required at times and without them a student's lesson participation as a performer in these sports will be limited. The required items are:

-Shin Pads (Hockey, Football)

-Gum Shield (Rugby, Hockey)

-Studded/Bladed boots (Football, Rugby)

In addition, it is important to remind you that students are not able to participate in any sport whilst wearing jewellery.

Unacceptable footwear:

Leather and/or canvas footwear made by sports brands such as Nike, Converse, Adidas and Vans maybe branded in shops as 'shoes' but at Myton they are classed as trainers and as such are not allowed in school. Nike 'Air Force One' style trainers do not meet the uniform code. This does not apply to PE where any type of trainer is accepted.



Hoodies

Hoodies are not allowed in school. Zip up jackets with hoods may be worn over blazers but hoods must not be worn up once on school site.
